Sustainable Procurement Policy

This policy establishes UNITAR's commitment to sustainable procurement practices that align with the Malaysian law, including the Government Procurement Bill 2025 and Ministry of Finance directives on Government Green Procurement. It aims to ensure that all procurement decisions contribute to environmental protection, social responsibility, and economic sustainability.

Guiding Principles

UNITAR shall adopt the following principles in its procurement processes:

- **Environmental Sustainability:** Preference for products and services that minimize environmental impact across their lifecycle.
- **Social Responsibility:** Support for suppliers who uphold fair labour practices, human rights, and community development.
- **Economic Efficiency:** Consideration of total cost of ownership, including maintenance, disposal, and long-term value.
- **Transparency and Accountability:** Compliance with procurement laws and ethical standards, including anti-corruption measures under the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2009 (Act 694)
